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# Leadership opportunities 2027

## Positions available in Student Leadership Group (SLG)



- Resident Assistants / Senior Resident Assistants
  - Pastoral care within College, working alongside Dean of Students
  - Receive Professional Leadership Scholarship, and may be paid for additional duties if required by College
  - Appointed by staff following applications and interview, for the following year
  - 17 positions in total
- Academic Assistants
  - Work alongside Vice Principal and Academic Project Officer
  - Receive a fortnightly stipend and may be paid for additional tutorials if requested
  - Appointed by staff following applications and interview, for the following year
  - 10-12 positions in total

  - First Year Rep elected early in Sem 1 2027
  - Variable leadership scholarships
  - Elected by students for the following year
  - 11 positions in total

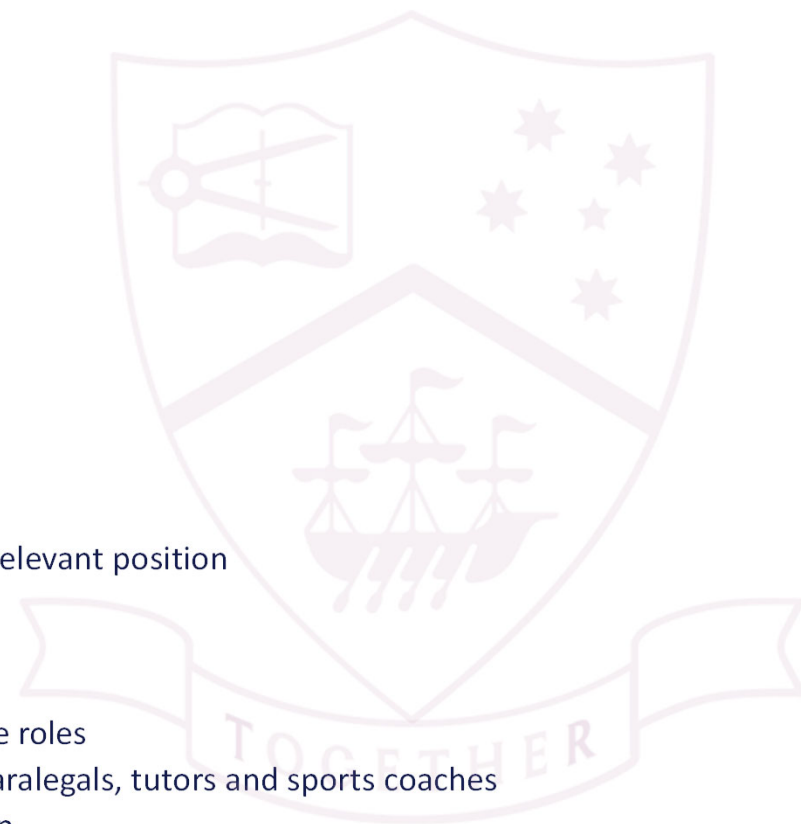
# Employment opportunities 2027

- Formally nominate themselves
- Submit **200** word professional statement to Vice Principal and HC Secretary

**21 September**

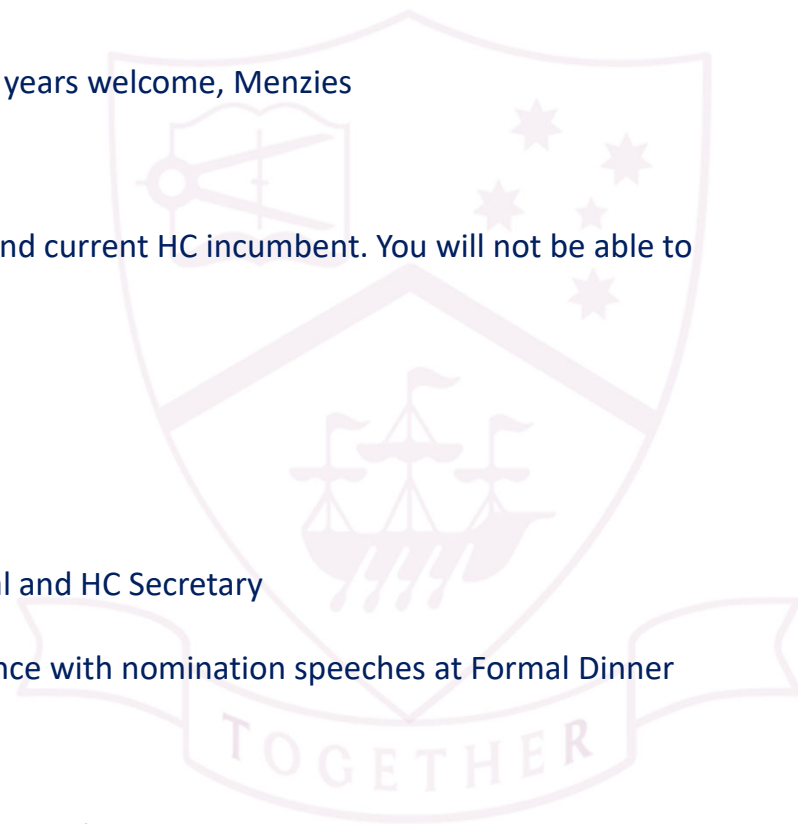
**Round 1:** HC Exec elections (SS, Sec/VSS, Treasurer) commence with nomination speeches at Formal Dinner

## **Resident Assistant, SRA and Academic Assistant positions**

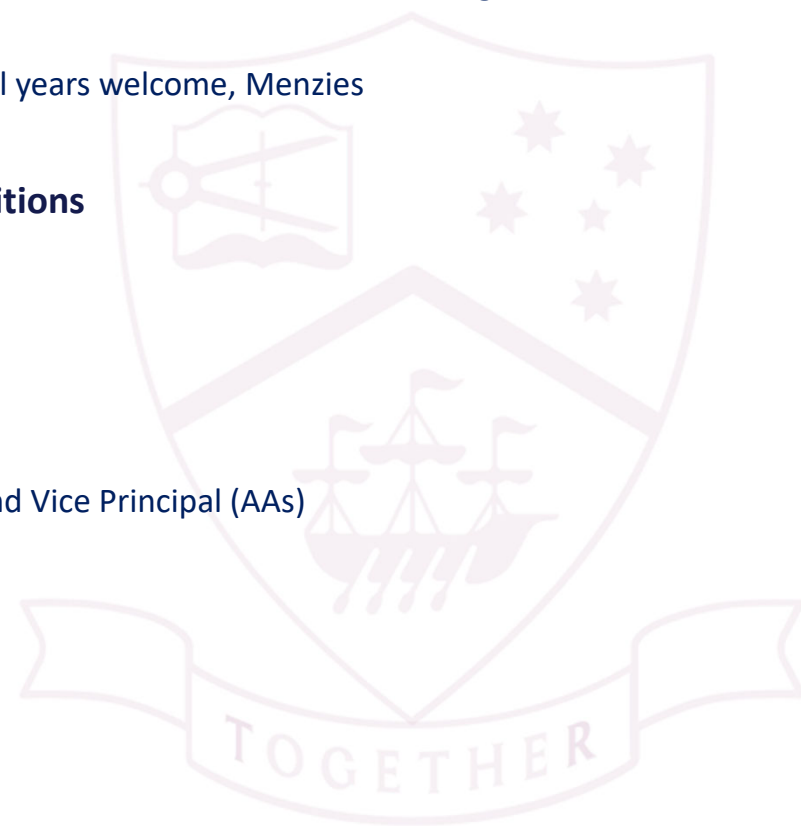
**Week 5** RA, SRA and AA positions advertised and open

**25 September** All RA, SRA and AA applications due, **5pm**

- Separate applications for each position being sought
- Apply with resume, cover letter and reference
- Submit applications to Dean of Students (RAs & SRAs) and Vice Principal (AAs)
- Students on exchange are permitted to apply for 2027

**Weeks 9 and 10** Interviews with shortlisted candidates

**Week 11** Successful and unsuccessful candidates notified

## Paulette Milliner

- A student from country NSW studying Humanities at the University of Sydney

## My Sydney

- Matching USyd scholarship

## Samantha Sinclair

- A student with academic merit in medical science with a focus on research

## Val Street

- A student who has displayed active participation in College activities and with a capacity to contribute to leadership

## Zonta Bicentennial

- A student in science, technology or engineering

# Grants and bursaries

## Students' Club financial hardship bursary

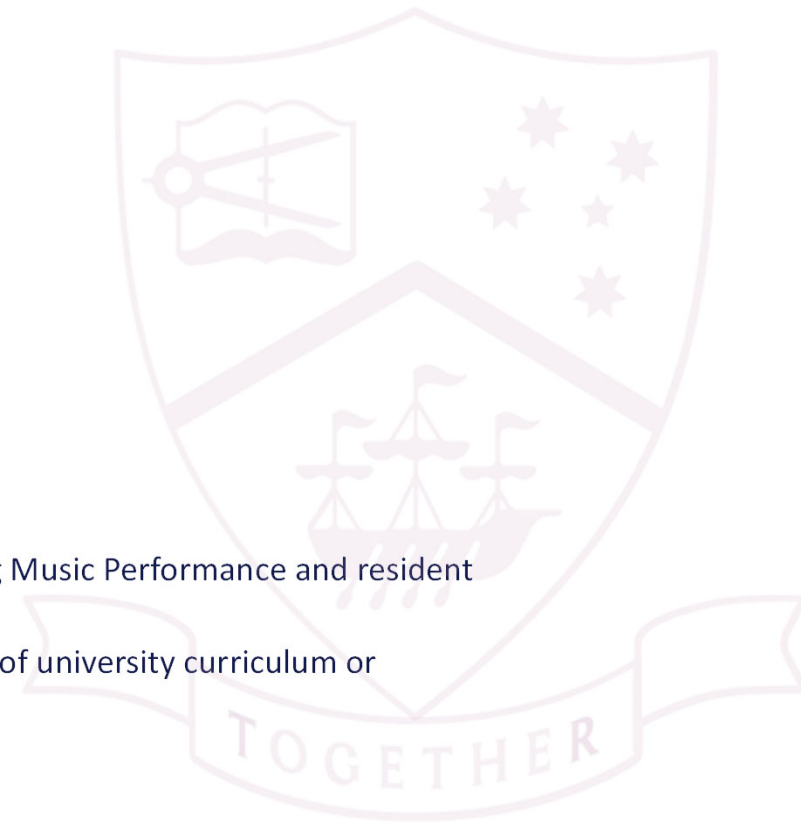
- Emergency financial support for a student experiencing financial hardship
- Apply directly to the Principal or Vice Principal *at any time*

## Sakuko Matsui Japan travel grant

- For a student in any discipline for exchange or a special project

## Doug and Margot Anthony (BUDD) music grants

- Two available
- Provide funds for music extension activities for a country student studying Music Performance and resident in College
- To be used for master classes, summer schools, specialist training outside of university curriculum or attendance at concerts that offer relevant experience for the student



# Grants and bursaries

## Sibyl Leadership Grant

- Funded by the Alumnae Association
- For a student in 4th year or above to develop their leadership capabilities for the professional world beyond their studies
- The applicant is encouraged to design their own 12-month leadership development program over and above the requirements of their degree
- \$10,000
- Separate application to the Vice Principal
- Dates and requirements are different to the Scholarship application and will be advertised in 2027



# FAQs

## Scholarship amounts

- Amounts granted differ, according to the various criteria
- Scholarships are assessed on merit and need. Every application is assessed on its own merit
- Generally used to partially offset fees, depending on need

## Offset fees

- Paid as credit against your fees
- Not given in cash
- Most scholarships are renewable beyond one year

## Already have a scholarship?

- Continuing students wishing to reapply need to submit a formal request for an extension with their 2026 scholarship report (due by **1 October 2026**)

## Do I need to apply for a particular named scholarship?

- No! There's one short application form, and Dr Donnelly will match the scholarship to you

## How to apply or renew

- All applications via the portal on the College website. See "Scholarships":
  - Tick the box for continuing students
  - Submit application for new students/scholarships
- All applications and requests for renewals are due by 5pm on **Thursday 1 October 2026**  
***Late applications cannot be considered.***

# Other scholarship opportunities

- All universities administer a wide range of academic scholarships and prizes
- USyd now has one application portal
- Australian Defence Force University Sponsorship – will pay approx. 40% fees, plus salary, all university fees, training and graduate position. Requirement to serve on graduation. (Speak to our Registrar if interested)
- There are also a wide range of scholarships available for postgraduate study in Australia and overseas
