Leadership opportunities 2027

Positions* available in Student Leadership Group (SLG)



- **Resident Assistants / Senior Resident Assistants**

- Pastoral care within College, working alongside Dean of Students
- Receive Professional Leadership Scholarship, and may be paid for additional duties if required by College
- Appointed by staff following applications and interview, for the following year
- 17 positions in total (14 x RAs, 3 x SRAs)

- **Academic Assistants**

- Work alongside Vice Principal and Academic Project Officer
- Receive a fortnightly stipend and may be paid for additional tutorials if requested
- Appointed by staff following applications and interview, for the following year
- 10-12 positions in total

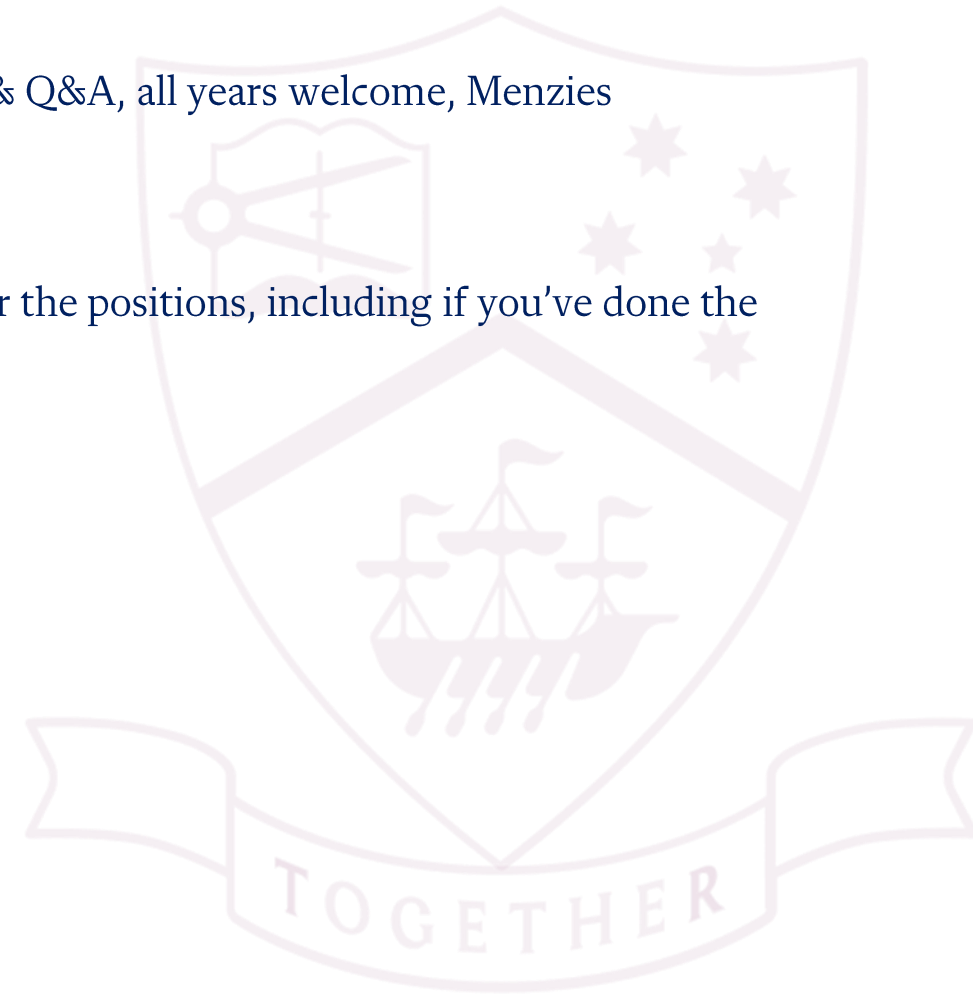

Week 5

All prospective candidates have meeting with staff mentor and current HC incumbent

Meetings open from now until Wednesday of week 7, 16 September

Your nomination will not go forward if you don't have this meeting – plan your time and book in early!
(If you cannot make the timing work with staff and incumbent, arrange two separate meetings.)

Week 6

11 September

Nominations due for all House Committee positions **5pm**.

All candidates must meet nomination guidelines:

- Have met with staff mentor and current incumbent
- Formally nominate themselves
- Submit 200 word professional statement to Vice Principal [pathways@thewomenscollege.edu.au] and HC Secretary [housecommsecretary@gmail.com]
- In addition to formal nomination HC Exec positions give 3 minute speech; other HC positions may submit 90 second video

21 September

Round 1: HC Exec elections (SS, Sec/VSS, Treasurer) commence with nomination speeches at Formal Dinner

22-24 September

HC Exec election period

13-15 October

Round 2: HC elections, non-executive positions (not First Year Rep)

What to do next: House Comm

- Read the PDs (position descriptions) of all roles you are thinking of applying to (available on woogle)
- Review the Voting Guidelines (available on woogle)
- Plan your time:
 - To include writing your bio, statement, speech, video
 - Book in for meetings with staff mentors
 - Find a students' club member (that is, any student of TWC) to endorse your nomination
 - Submit your nomination/s **by 5pm, Friday 11 September** to both the Vice Principal, Dr Rebecca Sheehan, on: pathways@thewomenscollege.edu.au **and** the Secretary, Amy Oaten, on: housecommsecretary@gmail.com
- Write and rehearse your speech/es and/or video – time limits will be strictly adhered to
- Encourage all Wizzies to vote – voting is not compulsory but is encouraged: every students' opportunity to have their voice heard

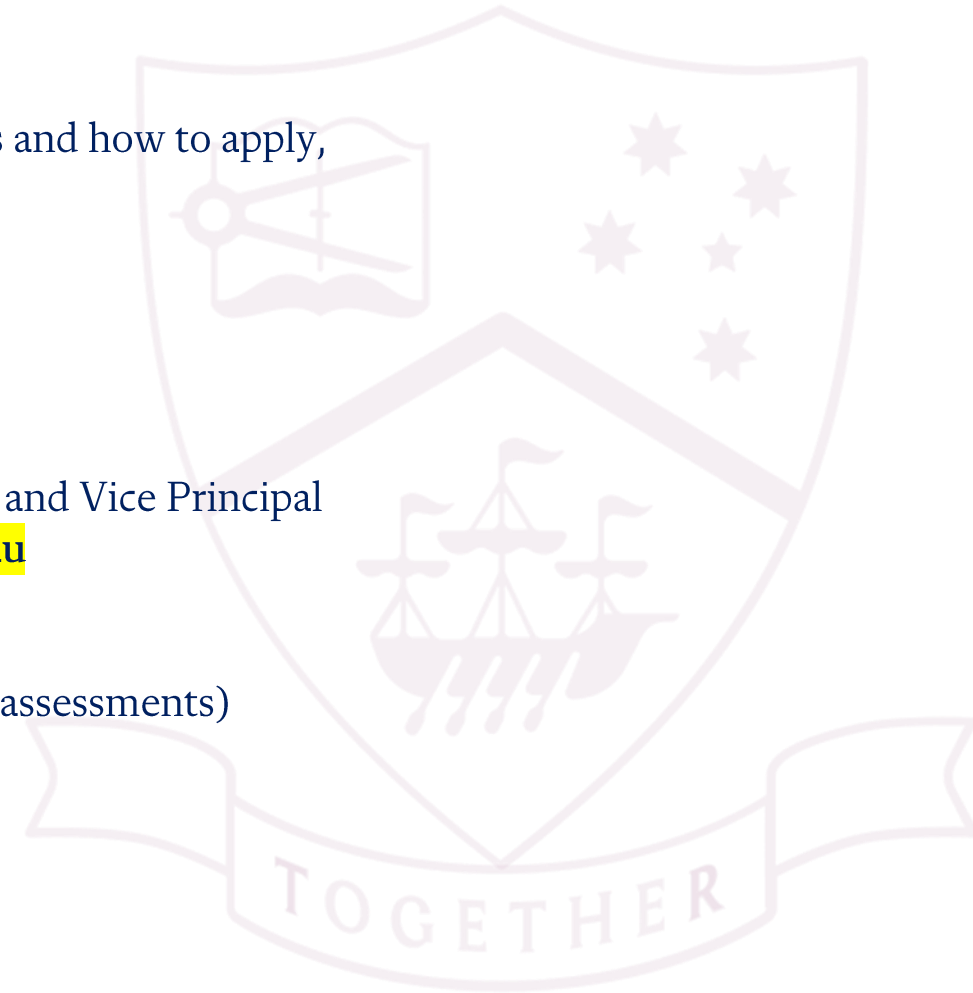
- Separate applications for each position being sought

- Submit applications to Dean of Students (RAs & SRAs) and Vice Principal (AAs) – email to **pathways@thewomenscollege.edu.au**
- Students on exchange are permitted to apply for 2027

Weeks 9 and 10

Interviews with shortlisted candidates (may involve group assessments)

Week 11

Successful and unsuccessful candidates notified



What to do next: RAs, SRAs, AAs

- Plan your time:
 - To include writing your bio and cover letter
 - To gather documents – references and/or academic record
[N.B.: please do not ask another member of College staff to write your reference]
 - Submit your application/s **by 5pm, Friday 11 September** to either the Vice Principal, Dr Rebecca Sheehan (AAs), or the Dean of Students, Meredith Garlick (RAs & SRAs) on: pathways@thewomenscollege.edu.au
- Make yourself available for interviews in weeks 9 & 10 (sign-ups TBA) – returning applicants will not participate in group assessments but will have a review meeting with their staff mentor
